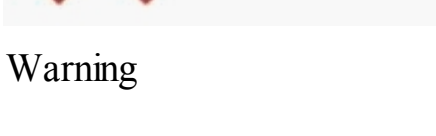

Hand protection

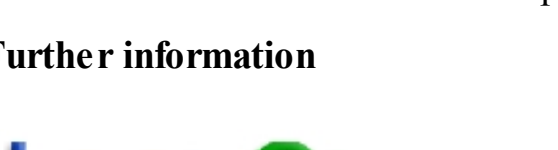
