General advice

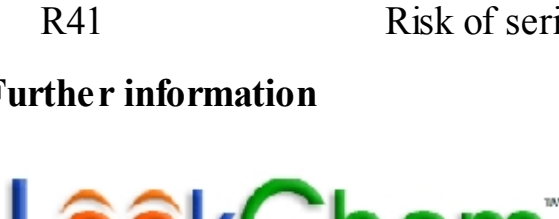
